Schedule of Regular Meetings for 2025

Scheduled meetings of the Brooklyn Village Council, the Brooklyn Planning Commission, the Corridor Improvement Authority, the Village Parks Board, the Intermunicipality Committee, and the Leoni Regional Utility Authority are open to the public as required by Public Act 267 of 1976, known as the Open Meetings Act. On occasion, portions of a meeting may be closed, but only in accordance with state law. Public comment provides an opportunity at each meeting for citizens to address members. If special accommodation is necessary for people to participate in any meeting, every effort will be made to provide appropriate and reasonable arrangements upon receiving adequate notice of the accommodation required. Special meetings of any public body shall be posted a minimum of 18 hours in advance of said meeting at the Village Office and on the Village website at www.villageofbrooklyn.com

BROOKLYN CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY (CIA)

Scheduled meetings are held at 8:30 a.m. at the Brooklyn Village Office, 121 N. Main Street, Brooklyn, Michigan, on the **third Tuesday** of the month. Special meetings may be held if posted a minimum of 18 hours prior to the meeting. Scheduled meetings may be cancelled by mutual consent of members if no business is brought to the CIA, also with 18 hours notice. Public Act 57 of 2018 requires a minimum of two meetings per year to be held, as noted below .
