RESOLUTION 2023-06-02 VILLAGE OF BROOKLYN SEWER FEE RATES

WHEREAS, the Water Fund and Sewer Fund for the Village of Brooklyn are intended to be self-sustaining enterprise funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn must periodically adjust water and sewer rates and fees to reflect changes in the appropriation of funds for the Water and Sewer Funds for the Village; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined that water and sewer rates must be equitable for all customer classes, including residential (both single- and multi-family), commercial and industrial; and

WHEREAS, the Leoni Township Board of Trustees approved a fee increase to all municipal customers for wastewater treatment of \$1.39 per RUE on a monthly basis effective July 1, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Columbia Township Board of Trustees approved a fee increase to all municipal customers for wastewater treatment of \$4.50 per RUE on a monthly basis effective July 1, 2023.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following monthly water and sewer rates and fees be established for all customers served by the Village of Brooklyn, effective July 1, 2023:

Water (No change)

- Commodity Rate (Usage): \$0.00435/gallon, plus
- Readiness-to-Serve (RTS): \$22.75/month

Sewer

- Commodity Rate (Usage): \$0.00600/gallon, plus (No change)
- Readiness-to-Serve (RTS): \$45.89/month (Increase of \$5.89/month)

Other Fees (New connections only; no change)

- Water System Connection Fee: \$2,000
- Sewer System Connection Fee: \$2,000
- Meter Installation/Replacement: Actual Cost of Meter and Installation
