

RESOLUTION 2025-05-01 VILLAGE OF BROOKLYN WATER RATES

WHEREAS, the Water Fund for the Village of Brooklyn is intended to be self-sustaining enterprise funds per the State of Michigan; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn has not increased Rates on the Water Fund since 2017 and must periodically adjust water rates to reflect changes in the appropriation of funds for the Water Funds for the Village.

WHEREAS, following the initial increase effective June 1, 2025, rates will increase July 1st, 2026, 2027, and 2028, at 3% to ensure financial stability of the fund in accordance with the State of Michigan Deficit Elimination Plan.

WHEREAS, the ready to serve charge will change to be based on the meter size.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following monthly water rates and fees be established, effective June 1, 2025:

Meter Based Ready-To-Serve Charge:

Residential/Commercial Meter - $\frac{5}{8}$ Inch - $\$22.75 \rightarrow \29.03 Residential/Commercial Meter - 1 Inch - $\$22.75 \rightarrow \29.03 Commercial Meter - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Inch - $\$22.75 \rightarrow \43.54 Commercial Meter - 2 Inch - $\$22.75 \rightarrow \58.05 Commercial Meter - 3 Inch - $\$22.75 \rightarrow \87.08 Commercial Meter - 4 Inch - $\$22.75 \rightarrow \116.10

Properties with additional Ready-to-Serve Charge per residential/commercial unit will be charged at the base of \$29.03 regardless of meter size.

Water Commodity Usage Rate Charge:

Increase of \$1.29 per 1000 Gallons $$4.35 \rightarrow 5.64 per 1000 Gallons

Water System Connection Fee: \$2,000

Meter Installation: Actual Cost of Meter and Installation
