RESOLUTION 2020-17 VILLAGE OF BROOKLYN WATER AND SEWER RATES

WHEREAS, the Water Fund and Sewer Fund for the Village of Brooklyn are intended to be self-sustaining enterprise funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn must periodically adjust water and sewer rates to reflect changes in the appropriation of funds for the Water and Sewer Funds for the Village; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined that water and sewer rates must be equitable for all customer classes, including residential (both single- and multi-family), commercial and industrial; and

WHEREAS, the Leoni Township Board of Trustees approved a rate increase to all municipal customers for wastewater treatment of approximately 11.36%, effective October 1, 2020.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following monthly water and sewer rates and fees be established for all customers served by the Village of Brooklyn, effective January 1, 2021:

Water (No change)

- Commodity Rate (Usage): \$0.00435/gallon, plus
- Readiness-to-Serve (RTS): \$22.75/month

Sewer

- Commodity Rate (Usage): \$0.00600/gallon, plus
- Readiness-to-Serve (RTS): \$40.00/month (No change)

Other Fees (New connections only; no change)

- Water System Connection Fee: \$2,000
- Sewer System Connection Fee: \$2,000
- Meter Installation/Replacement: Actual Cost of Meter and Installation

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that residential dwelling units are charged equally (regardless of dwelling size or whether separate connections exist); that charges by connection or water meter size are hereby abolished; that seasonal rates are abolished; and that rates charged to commercial and industrial customers are by each business location (regardless of whether separate connections exist).

On a motion by Village Council Member Krauss, seconded by Member Robinson, the Village of Brooklyn, County of Jackson, State of Michigan, by a majority vote of the Village Council, hereby approves the above resolution.
